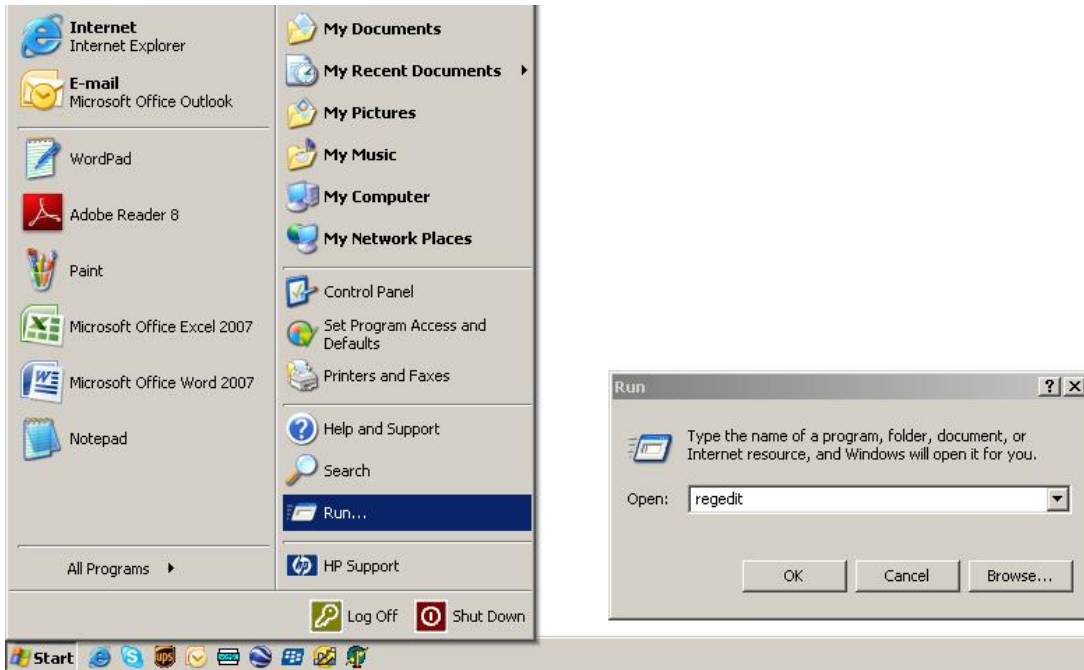


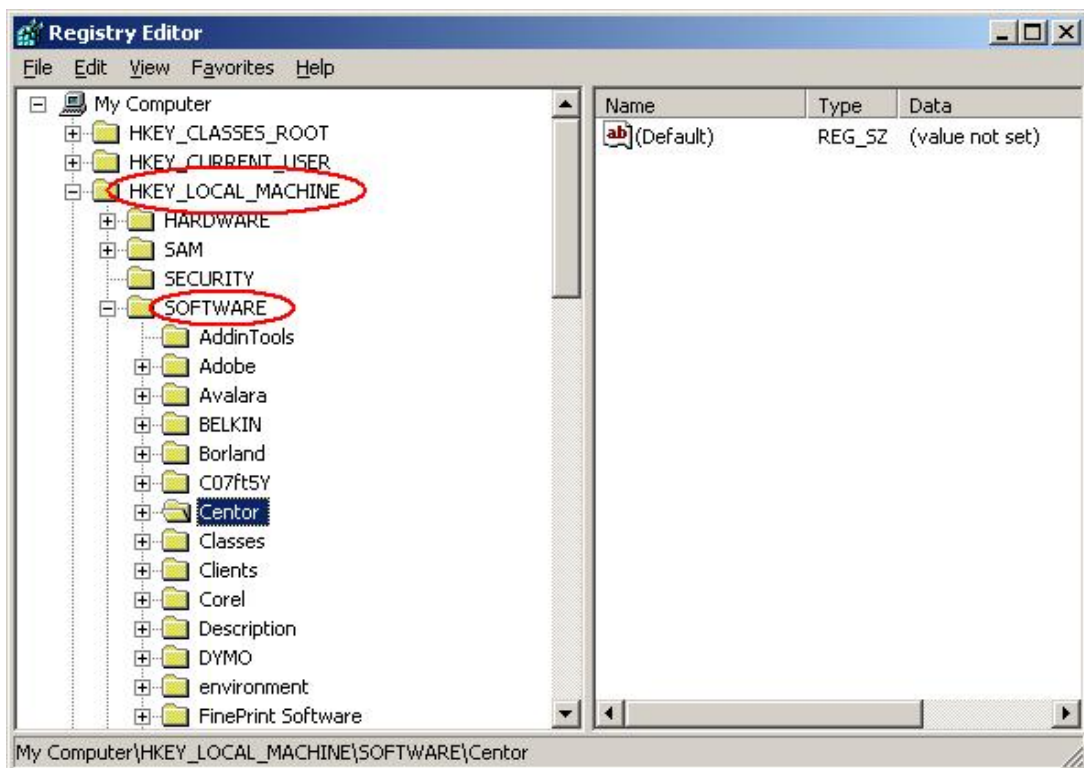
## How to Allow for Multiple Users

How to allow other users (different from the PC administrator) to run the GleasonESP download in Windows XP.  
(Note: This process is not necessary in Vista).

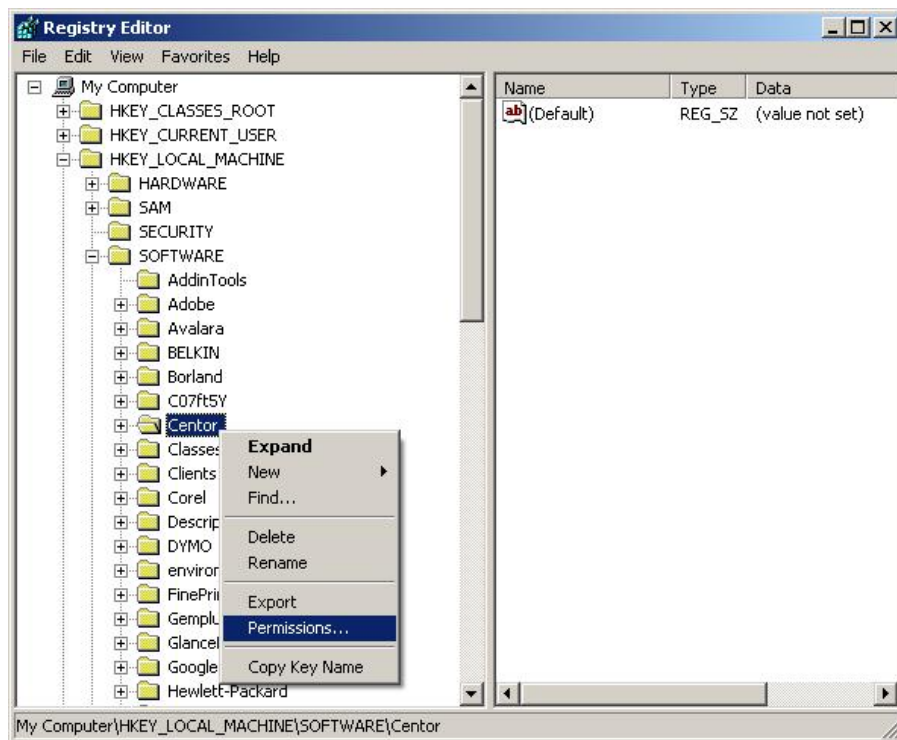
**Step 1:** Enter the Registry Editor by clicking on **Start**, then **Run**. Type “regedit” in the open scrollbar.



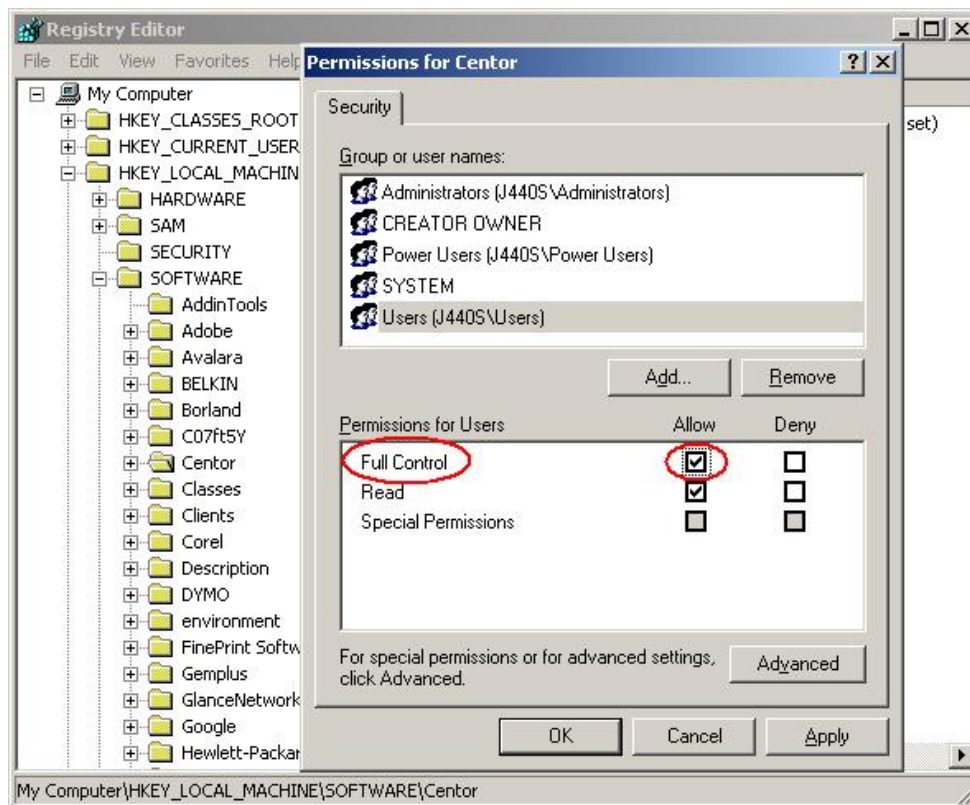
**Step 2:** Locate the “Centor” folder within the Registry Editor. To find this folder, expand the “My Computer” icon. Next, expand the “HKEY\_LOCAL\_MACHINE” folder and the “SOFTWARE” folder respectively.



**Step 3:** Right click on the “Centor” folder and select **Permissions**.

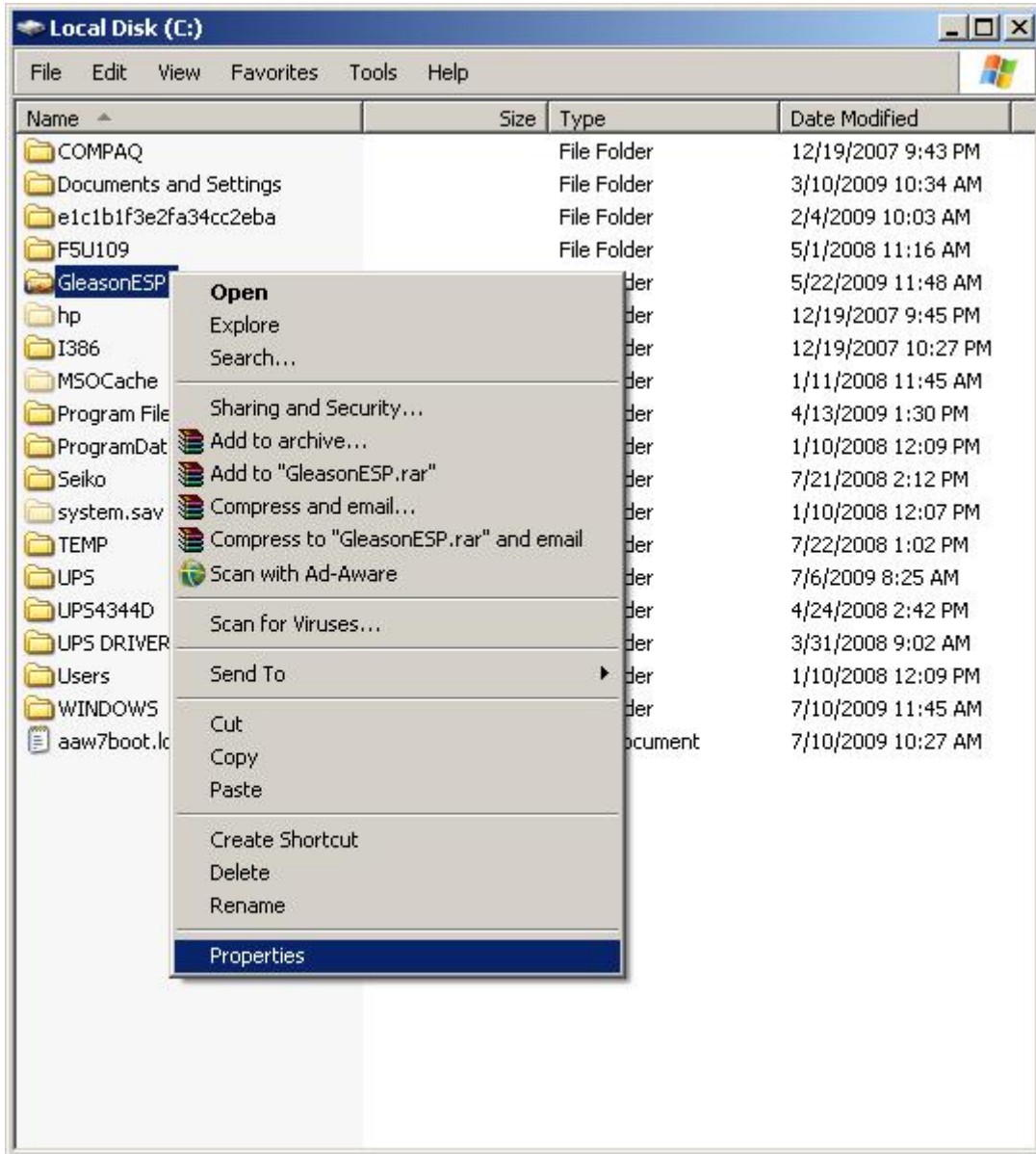


**Step 4:** Select **Allow-Full Control** for all groups or user names. Click **Apply** to make the changes.



**Step 5:** Click **OK**. Close the Registry Editor.

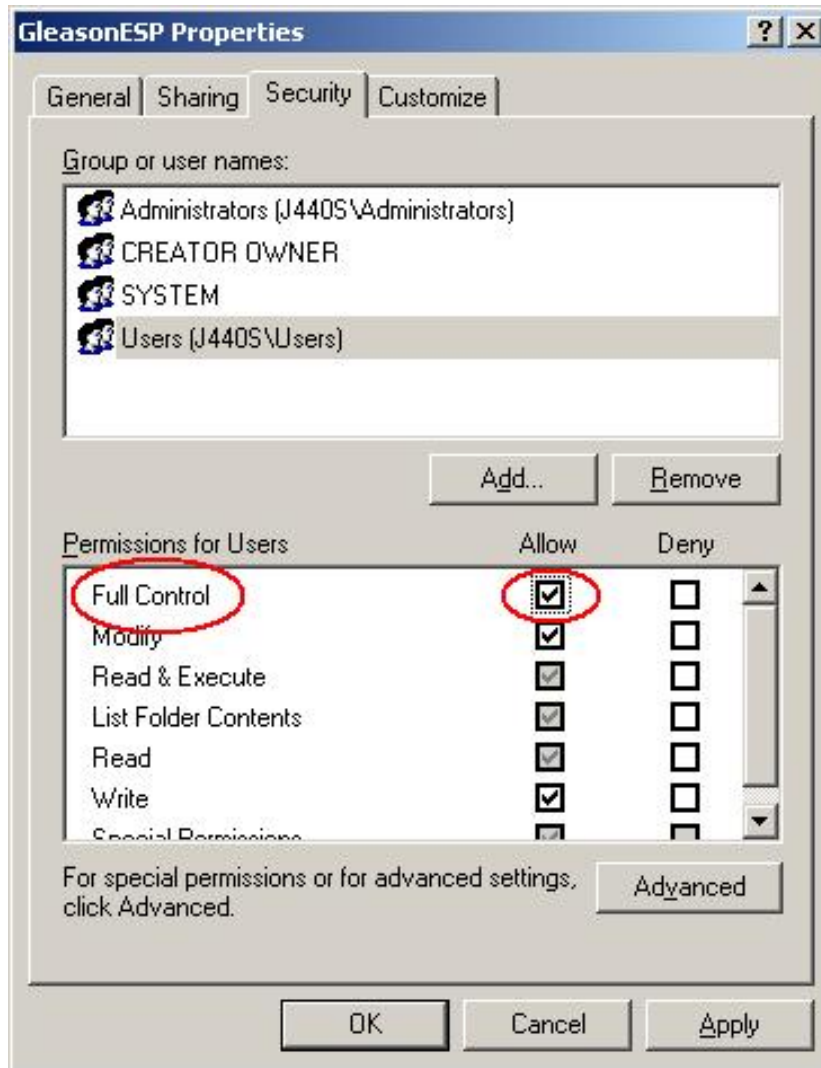
**Step 6:** Click on “My Computer” on your desktop. Click on “Local Disk (C:)” Right click on the “GleasonESP” folder and select **Properties**.



**Step 7:** Your screen will look either like the one below or the screenshot on the next page.

If your screen looks like this one:

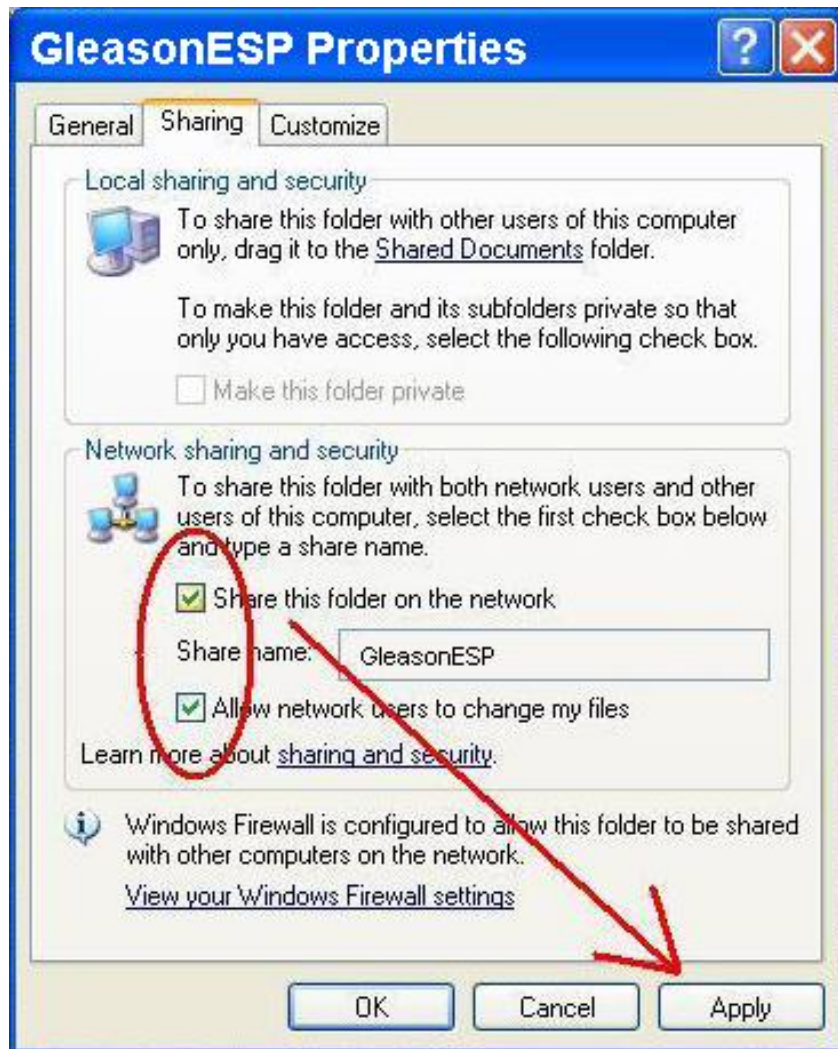
Click on the “Security” tab at the top of the screen. Select **Allow-Full Control** for all groups or user names. Click **Apply** to make the changes. Click **OK** to exit the screen.



Once this is complete, you may need to restart your computer.

If your screen looks like this one:

Click on the “Sharing” tab at the top of the screen. Be sure there is a check mark where it says, “Share this folder on the network” and where it says, “Allow network users to change my files”.
